About the course

A unique one-day intensive introduction to ergonomics and human factors, accredited by the Chartered Institute of Ergonomics and Human Factors (CIEHF).

This course is aimed at anyone looking to broaden their knowledge and understanding of ergonomics and human factors. If you currently have a general health and safety background, or you work in a specific area of ergonomics or human factors and are looking to expand your interest and capabilities, this course is designed for you.

You will take away a clear understanding of key ergonomics and human factors theories and techniques, and how the discipline plays a key role in health and safety risk management. You will receive a certificate of attendance.

The course also provides the basis for application to Technical Membership of the CIEHF, for anyone looking to begin steering their career towards ergonomics and human factors.

Practicalities

The course is a full day's training, covering a substantial amount of material over a short period. We provide Open and Closed (private) courses.

Open courses - Numbers are capped at 8 people per session. Standard timings are 9:30am to 5:00pm. Open courses are a good opportunity to network with others from a range of sectors and different backgrounds - to exchange ideas on implementing ergonomics and human factors.
